
All leave outside of the school holidays will be treated as unauthorised, this will go against your child's attendance record and in some cases may **incur a fine**

Payments for your child' Breakfast Club, After School Club, school meals and trips should be paid for via Agora. Any issues please let the office know. A Consent Form should be completed prior to starting a club. Breakfast Club is **£10 per** child per half term and After School Club is **£5 per** child per half term, Years 1-6 inclusive.
