Payments for your child' Breakfast Club, After School Club, school meals and trips should be paid for via Agora. Any issues please let the office know. A Consent Form should be completed prior to starting a club. Breakfast Club is £10 per child per half term and After School Club is £5 per child per half term, Years 1-6 inclusive. Karate on Fridays is £3 a session.
