Week 1 homework: Research 5 facts about the rainforest and write them as neatly as you can, practising your neat, joined up handwriting.

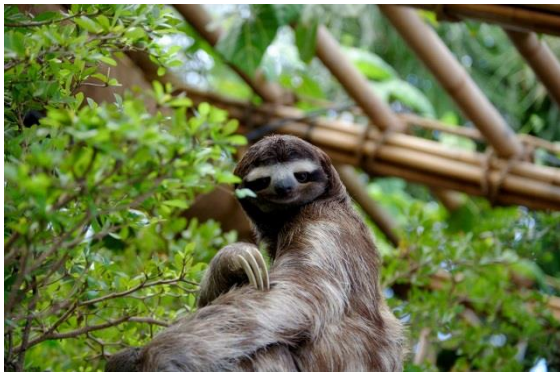
Week 2 homework: If you were an animal that lived in the rainforest, which one would you be? Draw and colour your favourite rainforest animal. Then, write some 5 facts about the animal around it!

Week 3 homework: Find out the meaning of the following words and explain what they mean in full sentences: tropical, canopy, climate, habitat, endangered, extinct, temperature and humid. (If you want to draw some pictures to help explain their meaning that would be lovely.)

Week 4 homework: Research deforestation and explain what you have found out about it. (Paragraphs and fronted adverbials will really impress me! E.g Firstly, I found out that)

Week 5 homework: Write an acrostic poem about the rainforest using all of the facts from class and from your own research. Remember this is how to set out an acrostic poem:

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Week 6 homework: What is palm oil and how is it damaging the rainforest? Please find out as much information about this as possible and write 2 paragraphs explaining what you have learnt.
