Our topic this half term is 'Rainforests'.


Week I homeworks Research 5 facts about the rainforest and write them as neatly as you can, practising your neat, joined up handwriting.

Week 5 homeworks Write an acrostic poem about the rainforest using all of the facts from class and from your own research. Remember this is how to set out an acrostic poems





Week 6 homework! What is palm oil and how is it damaging the rainforest? Please find out as much information about this as possible and write 2 paragraphs explaining what you have learnt.
