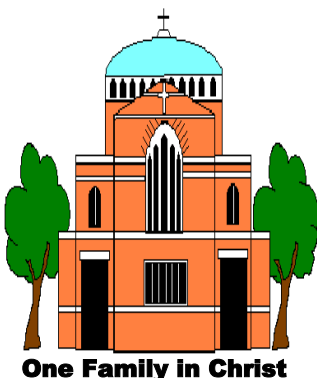
School meals should be paid for in advance, **£10.50 a week for Years 3,4,5, and 6** and **£5.50 a week for Nursery**. Payment can be made via SIMS Payment. If you have problems you should inform the office asap. Meal patterns can only be altered with prior notice being given to the office. Dinners increase **Sept 2019 to £2.20**

All leave outside of the school holidays will be treated as unauthorised, this will go against your child's attendance record and in some cases may **incur a fine**

If your child is going to be late for any reason or is off school poorly, you must call the office asap. You can always leave a message on the answerphone

Medicines to be administered to children in school should be handed into the office and a Medical Form should be fully completed

Payments for your child' Breakfast Club, After School Club, school meals and trips should be paid for via Agora. Any issues please let the office know. A Consent Form should be completed prior to starting a club. Breakfast Club is **£10 per** child per half term and After School Club is **£5 per** child per half term, Years 1-6 inclusive. Karate on Fridays is £3 a session.
