The Queen's Platinum Jubilee

To celebrate her seventy-year reign, there will be an extra Bank Holiday in 2022 to mark the Queen's Platinum Jubilee. The government website says:

The May Bank Holiday Weekend will be moved to Thursday 2 June and an additional Bank Holiday on Friday 3 June will see a four-day weekend to celebrate Her Majesty The Queen's Platinum Jubilee - the first time any British monarch has reached this historic milestone.

This historic event will reflect on Her Majesty's reign, and her impact on the UK and the world since 1952.

As schools are already on holiday at this time, it means that at the beginning of May, school will be closed for the early Bank holiday on Monday 2nd May and closed on Tuesday 3rd May - as this is when Eid is expected to fall, our families can celebrate Eid this year without their children having to miss a day of school.
